Review:

- 1. Legalism, making up and trying to follow our own code of conduct, only leads to hypocrisy
- 2. It's impossible for anyone to please God by ourselves, no matter how many rules we follow
- 3. Jesus Himself is the only way for anyone to live a life of integrity and obedience

Reflect:

- 10. In verse 16, what does Isaiah say it is foolish for clay to say to its potter?
- 11. What does God say will happen to Lebanon in verse 17? But what will happen to fields that had formerly been fruitful?
- 12. What does God say will happen to the deaf and the blind?
- 13. What does God say will happen to the humble and the poor?
- 14. What does God say will happen to the terrible and the scornful?
- 15. How does God describe the actions of the wicked in verse 21?
- 16. What does God say He did for Abraham in verse 22?
- 17. What does God say will not happen to Jacob?
- 18. What does God say the descendants of Jacob will do in verse 23?
- 19. In verse 24, how does God say that those who erred and complained will be changed?
