Review:

- 1. Being publicly associated with Jesus continues to be dangerous, putting us at odds with the unbelieving world around us
- 2. The exclusive claims of Christ that He is the only truth and the only way to the Father continue to be controversial
- 3. Because Jesus would not deny Himself, He brought salvation to all who profess faith in Him

1. In what situations have you found yourself hesitant to make your faith in Christ known? How does Jesus' example inspire you to greater faithfulness to Him?

- 5. In verse 4, what two things does Jesus insist that His disciples know?
- 6. In verse 5, what two things does Thomas insist that the disciples don't know?
- 7. In verse 6, what three things does Jesus say that He is?
- 8. What is the only way that Jesus says anyone can come to the Father?
- 9. What request does Philip make in verse 8?
- 10. In verses 7 and 9, Who does Jesus say people have seen if they have seen Him?
- 11. How does Jesus describe His relationship with the Father in verse 10?
- 12. With Whose authority does Jesus insist that He speaks?
- 13. Whose power does Jesus say lies behind the miraculous works He has done?
- 14. In verse 11, what two reasons does Jesus give that we should believe in Him?
- 15. What promise does Jesus make in verse 12 to those who believe in Him?
- 16. What promise does Jesus make to His disciples in verses 13 and 14? What is the reason He gives for keeping this promise?
- 17. In verse 15, what does Jesus say that those who love Him will do?

Summary and Application:

- 1. Given what Jesus says in verse 6, if Jesus is the only way to the Father, how can any other religion be true? And what does this mean for those without faith in Christ?
- 2. How does knowing Jesus' true identity help keep your heart from being troubled?
- 3. How does knowing Who Jesus is increase your desire both for prayer and for obedience to Him?
