Review:

- 1. Being faithful to Jesus has always required upholding His exclusive claims: that He is the only way and the only truth
- 2. Jesus refused to deny Himself, even though admitting His identity cost Him His life.
- 3. We should respond with love and faithfulness to the One Who laid down His life because He loves us

Reflect:

- 1. In what situations have you been tempted to keep your identity as a follower of Christ a secret? What were you afraid of losing if you made it clear that you were a disciple of Jesus?
- 2. Based on what you say and do, how easy do you think it is for other people to tell that you are a follower of Jesus? How can you make your discipleship more explicit?

Summary and Application:

- 1. Think about the things you might lose if others found out you are a follower of Jesus. Which of those things did Jesus' disciples have to give up in today's passage?
- 2. Based on today's passage, what do you think Jesus most wants to be most important to His friends?
- 3. Given the way Jesus reveals His identity in today's passage, how should you respond to Him?
