OUR COMMUNITY VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL will be held at Port Gibson Baptist Church from Monday through Friday this week. Children in grades K-6 should register at 8:30 on Monday, and VBS will be begin at 9am the rest of the week. VBS will conclude at noon each day.

BIBLE STUDY will take place this week at 7pm on Wednesday and 1pm on Thursday in the Annex.

COMMUNITY BIBLE STUDY is an interdenominational Bible study that brings people together as they study God's Word. The vision of CBS is to see lives transformed through the Word of God. CBS has over 700 classes in the U.S., and also classes in 99 countries around the world.

The Vicksburg CBS class for women will begin on Tuesday, August 23, from 9:30-11:30 and will be held at Crossway Church on Hwy 61 South. The class, which follows the school calendar, will meet each Tuesday, dismissing in early May. The 30 week course will include 18 weeks studying the Gospel of Mark, and 12 weeks focusing on 1 John, 2 John, and 3 John. The registration fee is \$35 per woman and \$10 for each child. Fees are waived in cases of financial need.

Children and youth, from nursery through high school, will also have the opportunity to learn God's Word through age-appropriate Bible lessons, crafts, music, and activities.

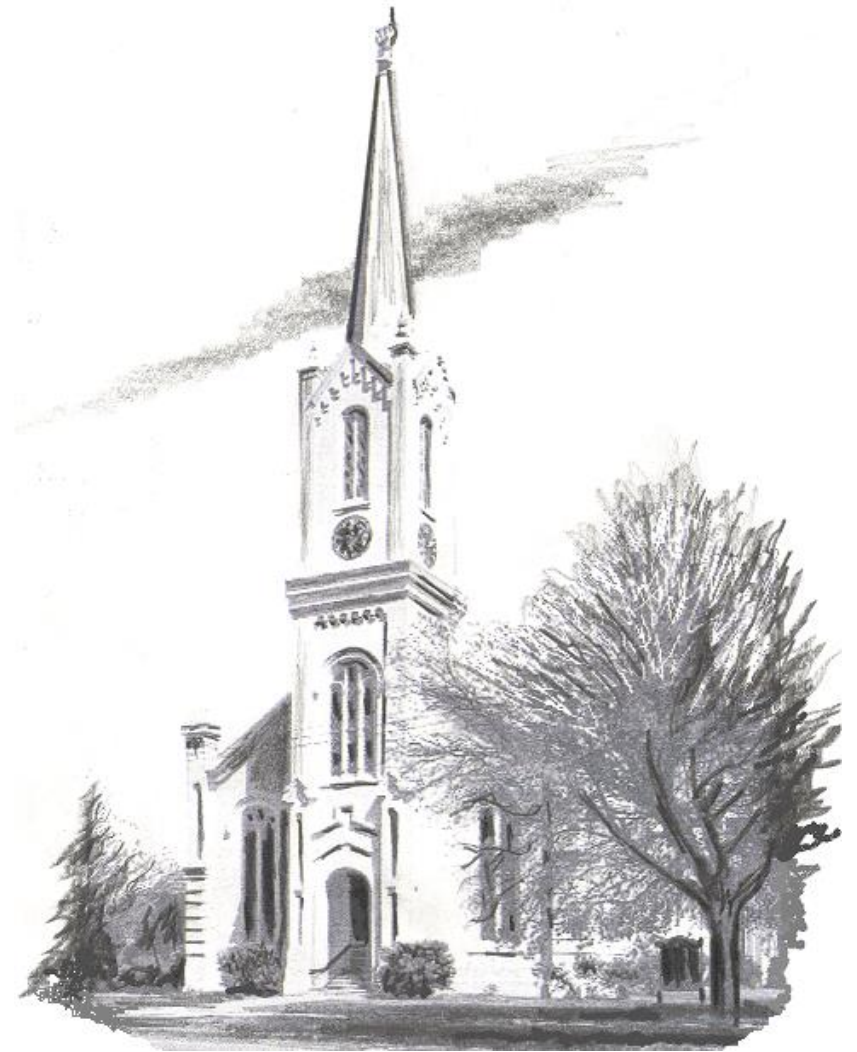
