- 7. There are four components of Jesus' preaching in verse 15. What do you think He means when He says, "The time is fulfilled?"
- 8. What do you think Jesus means when He says, "The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand?"
- 9. What is involved in repentance? What must those who repent give up?
- 10. What is the good news that Jesus calls everyone to believe?
- 11. What did Jesus tell Simon Peter and Andrew to do in verse 17? What did it cost them to obey Jesus?
- 12. In verses 19 and 20, what did it cost James and John to follow Jesus?
