The Importance of Remembrance Joshua 24:22-33

Review:

- 1. Memorials are important because memories, like people, don't last forever
- 2. Memorials are only helpful if they point us back to words, specifically God's Word
- 3. We need to remember the promises God has made to us and the promises we have made to God

Go Further: Read I Corinthians 15:1-4

- 1. In verse 1, what message does Paul say he has preached to the Corinthians? How does Paul describe their reaction to it?
- 2. In verse 2, what effect does Paul say his message has? What do his listeners have to do in order for the message to have this effect?
- 3. In verse 3, what does Paul say is of first importance? How did he learn the truth he preached?
- 4. In verse 4, what does Paul say happened to Jesus after He died?

Read Isaiah 53:4-12

- 5. What reason does Isaiah 53:4-6 give for the death of Christ?
- 6. In I Corinthians 15:3-4, Paul says Christ's death and burial were fulfillments of Old Testament Scripture. What details of Jesus' crucifixion and burial can you identify in Isaiah 53:7-9?
- 7. I Corinthians 15:4 says that Christ's Resurrection was also a fulfillment of the Old Testament Scriptures. How does Isaiah 53:10-11 point to the Resurrection?

Read I Corinthians 15:5-11

- 8. In verses 5-7, Paul lists many eyewitnesses to the Resurrection. Why is their testimony so important for us today?
- 9. Some "scholars" suggest that those who saw Christ alive after His crucifixion were simply victims of a mass hallucination or engaging in wish fulfillment. How do verses 5-8 make that explanation impossible?
- 10. To whom does Paul say in verse 8 that Jesus appeared?
- 11. Why does Paul say in verse 9 that he did not deserve to be called an apostle?
- 12. How does Paul say his life has been transformed in verses 10 and 11? What caused this change?
- 13. How does the change in Paul's life give us reason to believe in the truth of Christ's Resurrection?

Apply:

- 1. Why do you think it is so important that the death and resurrection of Christ fulfill ancient prophecies? What hope and assurance do you draw from this great truth?
- 2. How does the witness of the apostles to the life, death, and resurrection of Christ help to build your faith in Him?
- 3. How does remembering the great facts of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection make a difference in your life today?
