## Review:

- 1. God is the One Who delivers us, not governments or scientists.
- 2. God's deliverance and salvation may be in the next world rather than this one.
- 3. Because God is with us, we need not fear, regardless of the problems that face us

## Go Further – Read Matthew 3:16-4:11

- 1. Who descended upon Jesus in the form of a dove immediately after He was baptized?
- 2. What did the Father say about Jesus?
- 3. According to 4:1, where did the Spirit lead Jesus immediately after this tremendous, affirming experience? What was the express purpose of Jesus' trip?
- 4. How long did Jesus fast? Have you ever tried to fast before? How did it make you feel?
- 5. What did Satan tempt Jesus to do in 4:3? What would have been wrong with Jesus doing this?
- 6. What does 4:4 tell us about Jesus' priorities? How could this sort of perspective help us in our own times of temptation?
- 7. Why would Satan's idea in 4:5-6 have been tempting for Jesus? How could such a public display of His divine power have changed the course of His life and ministry?
- 8. In 4:6, Satan quotes from Psalm 91:11-12. How is Satan mistaken in his application of these verses?
- 9. In 4:7, why does Jesus say He will not display His power in such a way?
- 10. What does Satan promise Jesus in 4:8-9. Since Jesus deserves all honor and glory, why would this be wrong for Him?
- 11. How does Jesus respond to Satan's temptation in verse 10? How should Jesus' words inform our own priorities?

## Apply:

- 1. Have you ever had a time of joy and affirmation be followed by a time of difficulty and testing? How does such a change affect the way you felt about God's provision and protection?
- 2. Have you ever presumed upon God's blessings in order to get something you wanted? Why is that so damaging to your relationship with God?
- 3. How have you used God's Word to fight against your own temptations? How has God's Word helped you to conquer your fears?
